



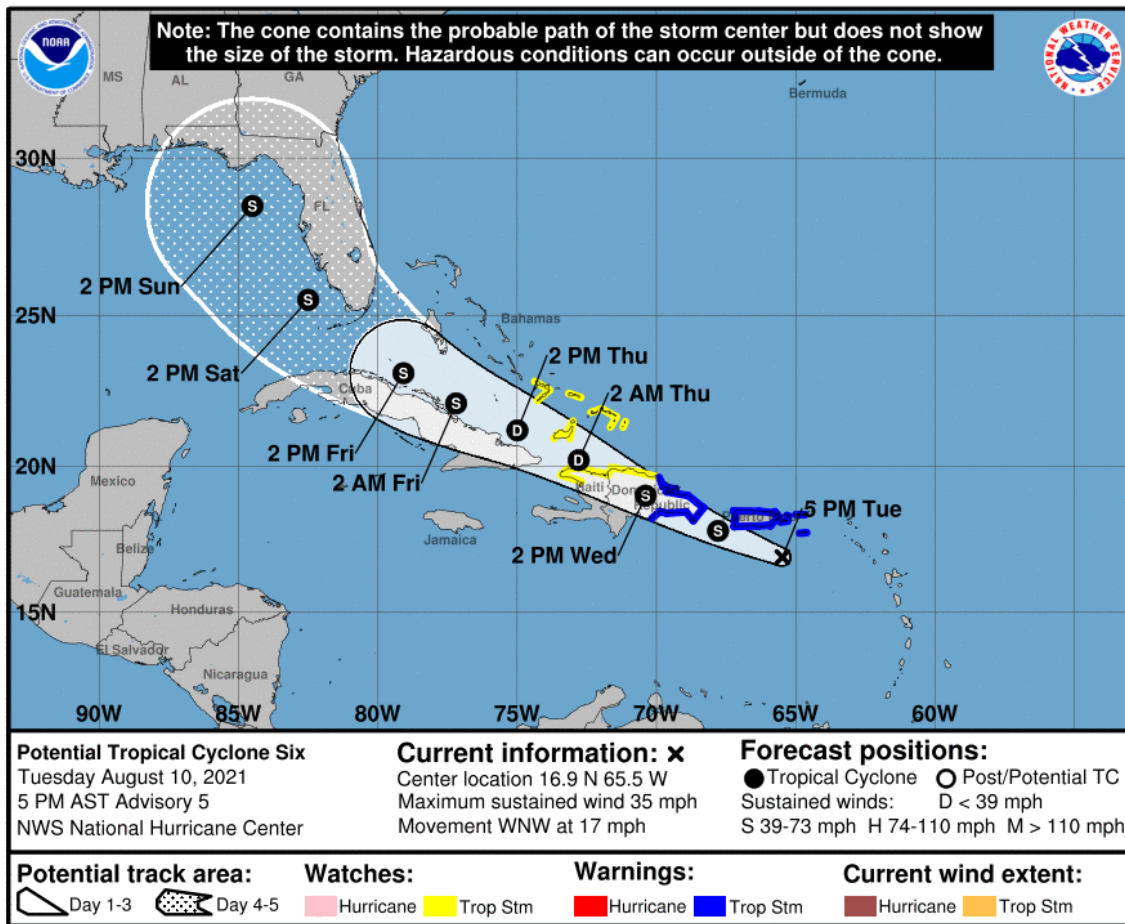
# Emergency Management



## POTENTIAL TROPICAL CYCLONE SIX ADVISORY #3

August 10, 2021

The Office of Emergency Management is actively monitoring Potential Tropical Cyclone Six. This system is currently moving West North West at 17 mph with maximum sustained wind speeds of 35 mph. Currently, all STOF Reservations and Communities are in the cone of uncertainty. This system is likely to become a Tropical Storm later tonight. The Office of Emergency Management will continue to monitor the storm's track and provide updates as new information becomes available.



We strongly encourage you to activate your family emergency plan and ensure your disaster supply kit is prepared. Your disaster supply kit should contain enough food, water and other items to sustain you for a minimum of 3 to 7 days.
