## COLD WEATHER ADVISORY

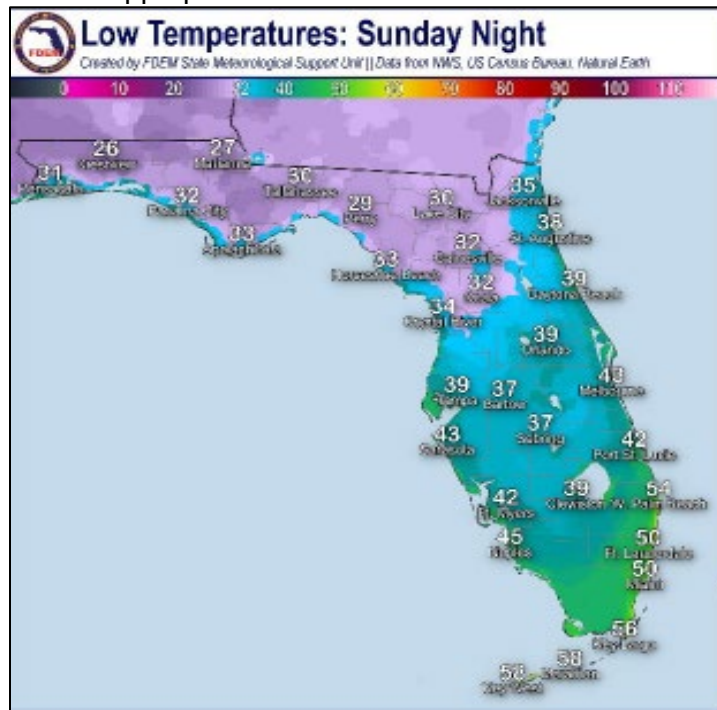

The National Weather Service has indicated cooler temperatures will affect Tribal Reservations & Communities starting Sunday morning through Monday morning as a result of a frontal passage occurring over the region, with the coldest temperatures expected during the overnight hours beginning Sunday night into Monday morning.

A summary of STOF Reservations affected during these overnight hours are as follows:

- Tampa: Nightly low temperatures with wind chills in the lower to upper 30s.
- Lakeland: Nightly low temperatures with wind chills in the lower to upper 30s.
- Brighton: Nightly low temperatures with wind chills in the mid-30s.
- Big Cypress: Nightly low temperatures with wind chills in the upper 30s.
- Immokalee: Nightly low temperatures with wind chills in the lower to mid-30s.
- Fort Pierce: Nightly low temperatures with wind chills in the lower 40s to mid-50s.

Please use caution during outdoor activities especially during the overnight hours, and consideration for plants and pets should also be made during this period. The Office of Emergency Management will continue to monitor and provide updates as appropriate.
