## COLD TEMPERATURES ADVISORY UPDATE

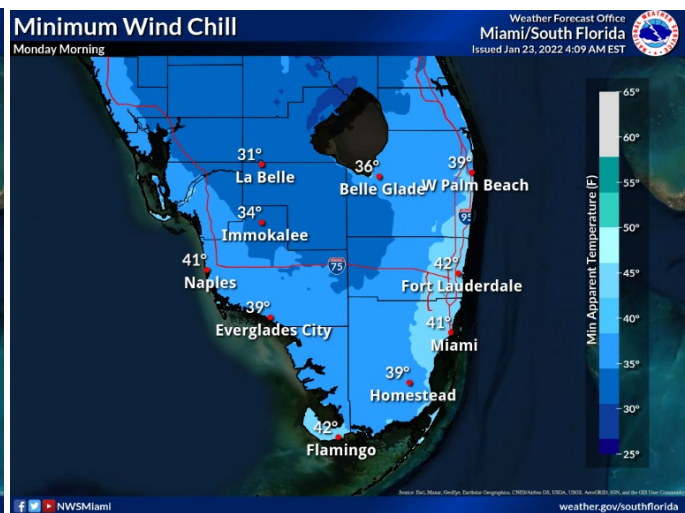
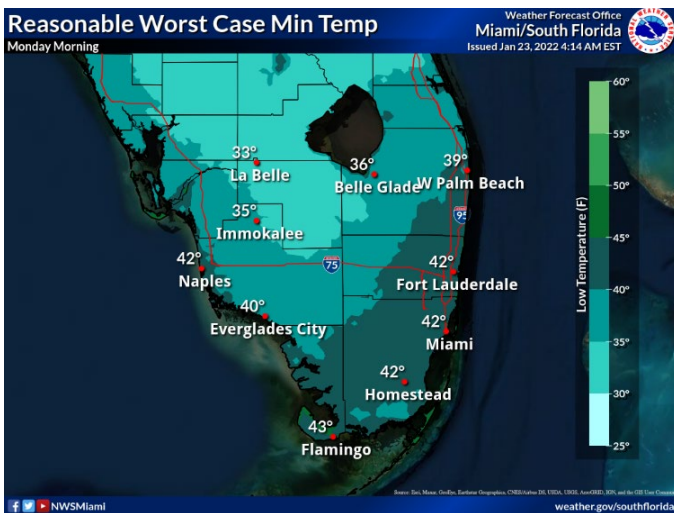
January 23, 2022

A Canadian high pressure ridge will build over the region impacting all Tribal Reservations and Communities today and tonight with clearing skies and much colder temperatures with freezing conditions possible in some areas.

Forecast low temperatures in the area starting late tonight and Monday morning will range from the upper 20s to lower 30s in the north and central areas of the region to the lower 40s south. A summary of STOF Reservations affected during these overnight hours are as follows:

- Tampa: Nightly low temperatures with wind chills in the lower 30s.
- Lakeland: Nightly low temperatures with wind chills in the lower 30s.
- Brighton: **Frost advisory**; nightly low temperatures with wind chills in the upper 20s.
- Big Cypress: **Frost advisory**; nightly low temperatures with wind chills in the lower 30s.
- Immokalee: **Frost advisory**; nightly low temperatures with wind chills in the lower to mid-30s.
- Hollywood: Nightly low temperatures with wind chills in the upper 30s to low 40s.
- Fort Pierce: Nightly low temperatures with wind chills in the lower 40s.

Please use caution during outdoor activities especially during the overnight hours, and consideration for plants and pets should also be made during this period. The Office of Emergency Management will continue to monitor and provide updates as appropriate.
