



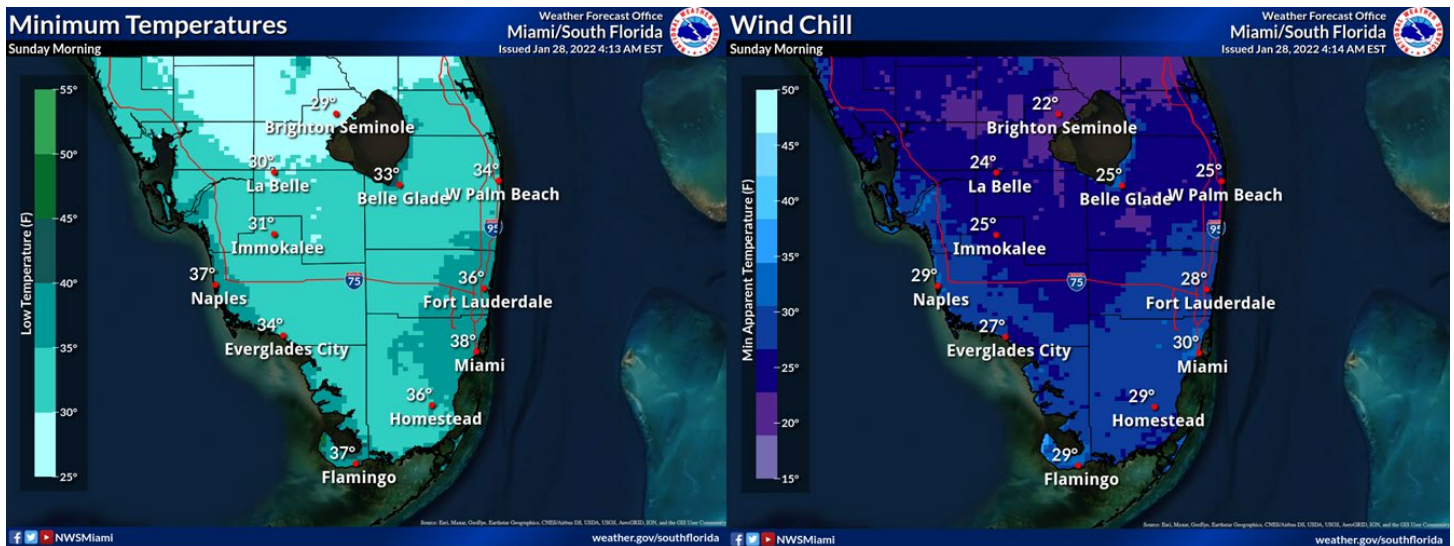
# Emergency Management



## COLD WEATHER ADVISORY

January 28, 2022

A strong cold front is forecasted to impact all Tribal Reservations & Communities starting Saturday and will continue throughout the weekend. All Reservations and Communities could see temperatures in the 30s and possibly high 20s throughout the weekend with the wind chill being lower. A Wind Chill Advisory and a Freeze Watch will be in effect for the Tampa Reservation, Lakeland Reservation, Brighton Reservation, Big Cypress Reservation, Immokalee Reservation, Naples Community and the Tamiami Trail Community for Saturday and into Sunday morning.



Please use caution during outdoor activities especially during the overnight hours. Please dress in layers to protect from exposure to extreme cold and frostbite. Areas most prone to frostbite are uncovered skin and the extremities, such as hands and feet. Hypothermia is another threat during extreme cold. Hypothermia occurs when the body loses heat faster than it can produce. Consideration for agriculture and animals should also be made during this period. The Office of Emergency Management will continue to monitor and provide updates as appropriate.
