



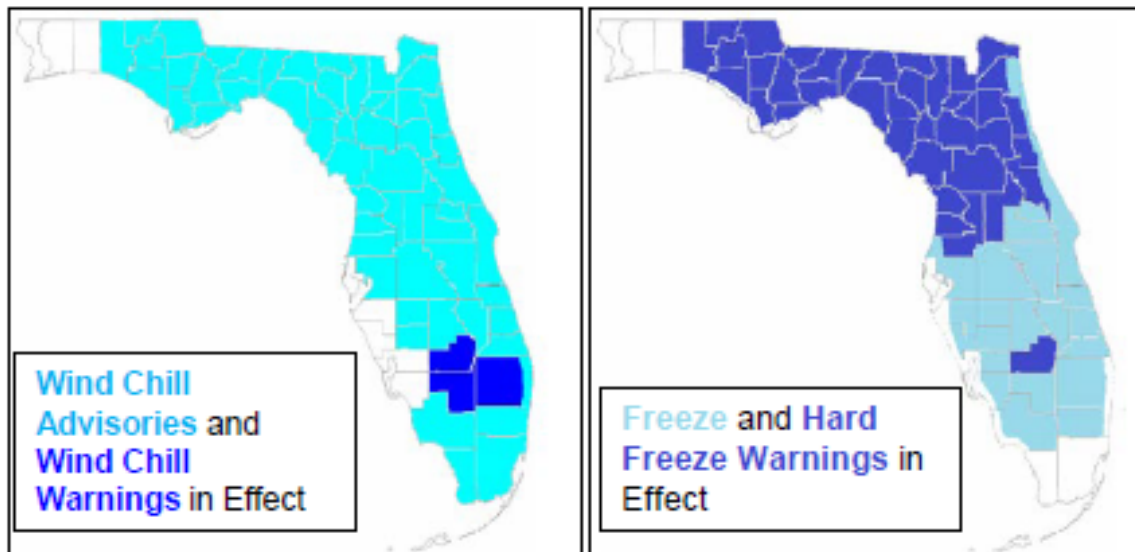
# Emergency Management



## UPDATED COLD WEATHER ADVISORY

**January 29, 2022**

A Wind Chill Advisory (*expected wind chill temperatures of 35 F or lower within 12 to 24 hours*) is in effect for the Tampa Reservation, Lakeland Reservation, Fort Pierce Reservation, Immokalee Reservation, Hollywood Reservation, Naples Community, and Tamiami Trail Community for Saturday night through Sunday morning. A Wind Chill Warning (*expected wind chill temperatures of 25 F or lower within 12 to 24 hours*) is in effect for the Big Cypress and Brighton Reservations for Saturday night through Sunday morning. A Hard Freeze Warning (*imminent threat of air temperatures 28 F or lower for a duration of 2 or more hours*) is in effect for the Brighton Reservation for Saturday night through Sunday morning. A Freeze Warning (*imminent threat of temperatures 32 F or lower*) is in effect for the Tampa Reservation, Lakeland Reservation, Fort Pierce Reservation, Big Cypress and Immokalee Reservations for Saturday night through Sunday morning.



Please use caution during outdoor activities especially during the overnight hours. Please dress in layers to protect from exposure to extreme cold and frostbite. Areas most prone to frostbite are uncovered skin and the extremities, such as hands and feet. Hypothermia is another threat during extreme cold. Hypothermia occurs when the body loses heat faster than it can produce. Consideration for agriculture and animals should also be made during this period. The Office of Emergency Management will continue to monitor and provide updates as appropriate.
