HURRICANE IAN ADVISORY #9

September 27, 2022

A Hurricane warning remains in effect for the Tampa Reservation, and Lakeland Reservation.

A Tropical Storm warning remains in effect for the Naples Community, Tamiami Trail Community, Immokalee, Big Cypress, Brighton, and Fort Pierce Reservations.

A Tropical Storm watch is now in effect for the Hollywood Reservation

The Office of Emergency Management continues to monitor Hurricane Ian. This system is currently moving North at 10 mph with maximum sustained wind speeds of 115 mph. At this time, all Reservations and Communities are on a flood watch. Currently, due to the uncertainty of the storm track we are advising all Reservations and Communities to prepare for storm impacts. The Office of Emergency Management will continue to monitor the storms track and provide updates as new information becomes available.

Below are potential projected rain totals through Tuesday morning:

Tampa Reservation: 15-20 inches

Lakeland Reservation: 6-15 inches

Fort Pierce Reservation: 4-10 inches

Brighton Reservation: 4-10 inches

Immokalee Reservation: 2.5-6 inches

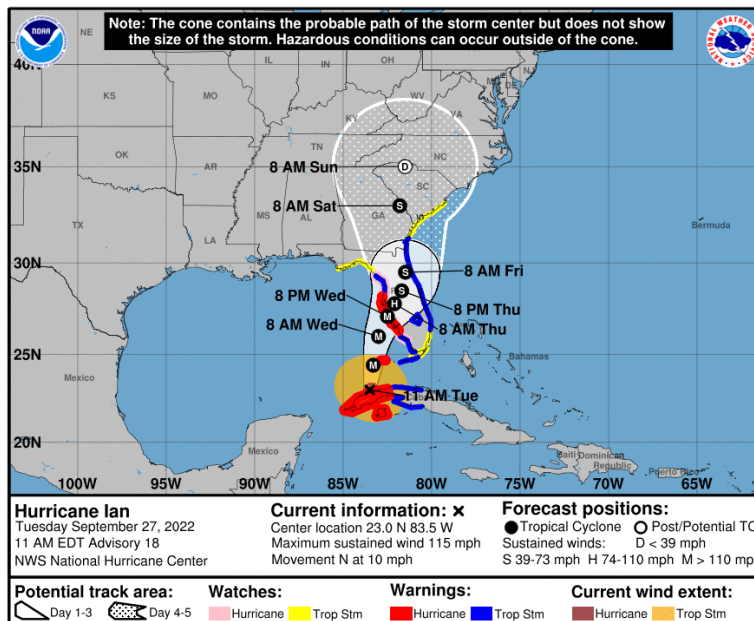
Naples Reservation: 5-8.5 inches

Big Cypress Reservation: 4-10 inches

Hollywood Reservation: 3.5-7 inches

Tamiami Trail Community: 4-10 inches

*These totals may increase or decrease depending on storm track
