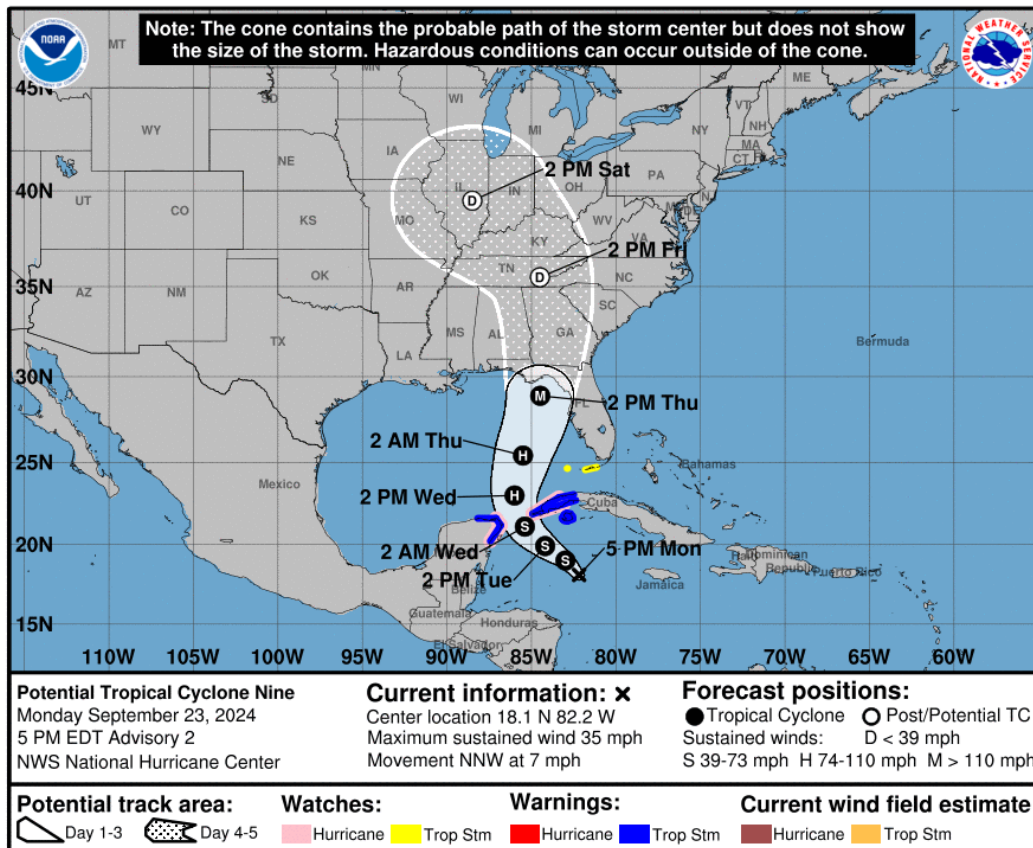


POTENTIAL TROPICAL CYCLONE ADVISORY #2

September 23, 2024

The Office of Emergency Management continues to monitor Potential Tropical Cyclone 9. The system is currently moving north northwest at 7 mph. The National Hurricane Center believes this storm may turn into a Major Hurricane prior to landfall on Thursday. There are still some lesser relied upon models that show a possible landfall north of Tampa. Due to the uncertainty in the forecast, we are advising all Reservations and Communities to be aware of the storm, and to prepare for possible storm impacts.

This storm could bring heavy rains that could cause flooding throughout the State and the Tribe is monitoring and managing the water storage on all Reservations. Strong wind gusts on the west coast of Florida can be anticipated regardless of the track. Please use caution as you plan your travels this week especially to various activities on the Reservations and monitor your news channels for local forecasts as future watches and warnings may be issued. The Office of Emergency Management will continue to monitor the storms track and provide updates as new information becomes available.
